HILLARYS PROTECTED ENTERTAINMENT PRECINCT

Thank you for your correspondence dated 20 October 2025 regarding the City of Joondalup's feedback on the operation of the Protected Entertainment Precincts Scheme.

The Hillarys Protected Entertainment Precinct falls within the City of Joondalup's jurisdiction; therefore, the City's comments are limited to this specific precinct rather than the scheme in its entirety.
